



Buest Arrival and Lunch Procedures at Warren Hills

This document is intended to remind parents and guests of our arrival and lunch procedures at Warren Hills. Guest Arrival Procedures

- 1. When parents or guests arrive, please use the intercom system to announce who you are and who you are here to pick up or visit.
- 2. Stand on the painted feet, as this helps ensure that we can see your face on the video monitor.
- 3. Each individual person needs to ring the buzzer to gain access to the building. Please do not enter the building with people outside your party.
- 4. Please be patient if you are not addressed immediately, as sometimes our office staff may be taking a phone call and can't get to the buzzer right away.
- 5. Once you enter the office reception area, you will be required to provide a government issued I.D. for check in and all visitors will be required to wear a visitor name badge provided by the office.

Guest Lunch Procedures

- 1. Please be sure to wait in designated locations prior to your child's lunch time.
- 2. When your child's lunch has concluded, please say good bye at the cafeteria doors. The teacher will escort your child back to the classroom at that time.
- 3. Please return to the office and return your badge following your time at lunch with your child. Volunteering opportunities should also be cleared with your child's classroom teacher.
- 4. Due to privacy issues, videotaping or photographing is not permitted unless it is your own child.

<u>Please note</u>: Due to our student population and limited lunchroom seating - Lunchtime visits are limited to no more than 1-2 visitors per student, per week. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.
