It has been great to see our students return this week for the start of the second semester in LPS! We wanted to share with you some additional information and reminders as we now transition to working our *Return to Learn* plan. In recent days, our health services team has been working to develop a *Frequently Asked Questions* document that addresses several of the recent updates to our plan. To access this document, click here.

As part of our *Return to Learn*/COVID-19 communication protocols, we will continue providing daily email updates to our building families in the event that COVID-19 case(s) are reported. This semester, an added layer of communication will include a notification to families if a COVID-19 positive individual was present in your child's classroom. This new automated system is expected to launch in a few weeks. The LPS COVID-19 Dashboard will also continue this semester and will be updated each Monday by 5 p.m. throughout the remainder of the school year. The dashboard will not only provide weekly district-wide COVID-19 case totals, but also a building-by-building summary of both in-district and out-of-district cases reported. Daily building-wide updates will resume on Monday, January 10, 2022.

We hope you find this information helpful as we continue our priority of providing five days per week of in-person learning for our students in a safe and healthy learning environment. We will remain committed to providing you with any additional information in the days, weeks, and months ahead, as necessary.
